Novice Coach Training

Coach's Training Workshop – Novice coaches will be trained to teach students the six-step process used in booklet competition.

- This session will also introduce scenario writing, community problem solving, understanding evaluation, coaching tips, and how to incorporate all three components in the resource classroom, in content area classrooms, and with other delivery models for meeting the needs of the gifted student.
